and animals (duck, turtle, eel, shark, guppy).

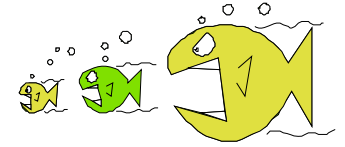
Tune: Old MacDonald

Old MacDonald had a pond. E, I, E, I, O.



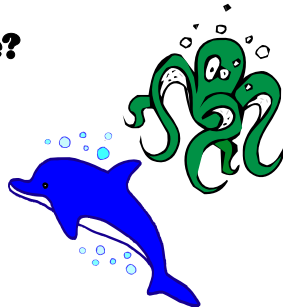
Tune: Frere Jacques

Swim away! Swim away!



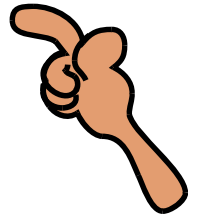
Tune: Did You Ever See a Lassie?
